



PHOTO CONSENT

Written consent from the parent/guardian or a child or young person under the age of 18 years is required before taking any photographs or making any digital or video recordings of that child or young person when they can be clearly recognised in an image. This is because an image of a child is personal data for the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998 and it is a requirement of the Act that consent is obtained. Failure to obtain consent may result in prosecution. Consent lets the parent/guardian know why the image is being taken/used, how long it will be kept and when/how it may be used. If there is more than one purpose it must be listed and the parent/guardian should be given the option to opt out if there is more than one purpose.

Consent must be sought prior to the photographs being taken and used.

Parental/guardian consent will need to be given to allow photographs to be taken. Parents/guardians must be asked to sign to say they agree to photographs being taken, used and stored.

It is always preferable that the consent of a parent/guardian is obtained in writing

Images should be destroyed two years after the date on the consent form unless further consent has been obtained for future use. If images exist of children that were obtained without consent, they should not be used and must be destroyed.

Images taken by parents, legal guardians or family members at a an event

- Parents, legal guardians, family members and friends can take images of their child and friends participating in activities for family and personal use.
- Any images must be taken for personal use only and images including others must not be put on the web/internet including facebook and that if they are Data Protection legislation may be contravened.
